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TOURNAMENT RULES

TOURNAMENT RULES FOR UNDER 9 TO UNDER 14

- 1) Managers should report to the control point with their team lists at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the tournament. All players in a team must have been under the age of the relevant age group on 31st August 2021.**
- 2) For ages Under 9 to Under 10, each team shall consist of up to 9 named players, not more than 6 of which are to be allowed on the pitch at any time. For ages Under 11 to Under 12, each team shall consist of up to 8 named players, not more than 6 of which are to be allowed on the pitch at any time. For ages Under 13 to Under 14, each team shall consist of up to 7 named players, not more than 5 of which are to be allowed on the pitch at any time.**
- 3) “Roll on roll off” substitutions will apply throughout the event. A player may not play for more than one team in a particular age group. A player sent off during a game shall take no further part in the event. If a player is cautioned, he misses the next game. If a player receives a 2nd caution he can take no further part in the remainder of the tournament.**
- 4) A match ball (size 3 for Under 9 and size 4 for Under 10-U14) will be provided by the first named team. If in the referee’s opinion there is a strip clash, the second named team will change. Results of the games should be reported to the control point by the winning team or in the event of a draw, the first named team.**
- 5) Normal time for games will be 5 minutes each way, with the exception of the final, which will be 7 minutes each way. Opposing team members shall retire at least 3 metres from any dead ball situation. Goal kicks shall be taken as a throw from the goal line. The goalkeeper must return the ball by throwing in open play. You cannot score direct from a centre kick.**

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TOURNAMENT RULES

6) In group games, 3 points are awarded for a win and 1 point is awarded for a draw. Should teams be equal on points in the group section, then the highest placed team is decided, in order of priority, by:

- a) Result between the equal teams,
- b) Goals scored,
- c) Goal Difference
- d) If sides cannot be separated by any of the above then the toss of a coin will be used to determine the outcome.

Where qualification of the best placed runners-up or third placed is dependent on comparison of results of teams from different leagues and where there are unequal numbers of teams in the leagues, first points, then goals scored based on averages per games played and then goal difference, will be used to determine the highest placed teams. If still equal at this stage Rule 6d will determine the result.

7) There will be no extra time in the knockout stages other than the final. In the Final if the scores are level at the end of normal time there will be extra time of 3 minutes each way. Should teams be level after extra time, two players from each team will be withdrawn from the pitch, the use of the goalkeeper shall not be allowed, and further extra time of 3 minutes each way will be played until one team scores. Should this produce no goals, a penalty shoot out will decide the result. The penalty shoot out will involve any 3 players from each side and if it is still level then it enters sudden death until there is a winner.

8) Except as above, normal FA laws apply and the decision of the referee on all points of play shall be final. Any disputed point, other than that of play, must be lodged with Control within 10 minutes of the game ending and shall be decided by the Control Committee, whose decision shall be final.
