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TOURNAMENT RULES

FESTIVAL GUIDELINES FOR UNDER 7 TO UNDER 8

- 1) Managers should report to the control point at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the event with a completed registration form. All players in a team must have been under the age of the relevant age group on 31st August 2021. All players will receive a medal.
- 2) For U7 each team shall consist of up to 8 players, not more than 5 of which are to be allowed on the pitch at any time, U8 each team shall consist of up to 10 players, not more than 7 of which are allowed ot be on the pitch at any time. "Roll on roll off" substitutions will apply throughout the event. A player may not play for more than one team in a particular age group. A player sent off during a game shall take no further part in the event. If a player is cautioned, he misses the next game. If a player receives 2 cautions he cannot take any further part in the remainder of the tournament.
- 3) A size 3 football will be provided by the first named team. If in the referee's opinion there is a clash of strip, the second named team will change. Results of the games should be reported to the control point by the winning team or in the event of a draw, the first named team. The first named team will have choice of end, the second named team will kick-off.
- 4) Games will be 7 minutes long in total with no half time.
- 5) The matches will be played by FA Rules.
- 6) The decision of the referee on all points of play shall be final. Any disputed point, other than that of play, must be lodged with Control within 10 minutes of the game ending and shall be decided by the Control Committee, whose decision shall be final.
